WIFI	PARKING
WIFI NAME Wifi / Salon / Cuisine / SPA PASSWORD Holidays (capitalized)	You can park two vehicles inside the property and two vehicles outside (in front of the gate). Be sure to lock the gate securely as soon as you enter. The wind is blowing very strongly.
HEATING	WASTE SORTING
The radiators are equipped with motion sensors and automatically adjust the temperature based on whether the room is occupied. If you hear a beep, it indicates a sudden drop in temperature (due to an open door or window). Simply press the “window” button briefly to stop the beep and turn the heat back on. Please do not turn them off, and do not place anything on them or use them to dry items.	.Packaging → in the yellow bin. .Glass → in the glass recycling bin at La Cambe, near the grocery store. .Organic waste (peelings, coffee grounds, eggshells, etc.) → in the compost bin, without meat, cheese, or plastic labels. .All other waste → in the black trash can. Trash cans must be placed at the curb on Monday evening.

CHECK IN

Self check-in is available.

CHECKLIST CHECK OUT

THINGS TO DO BEFORE LEAVING, PLEASE

For your peace of mind, professional cleaning is included in your reservation.
We simply ask that you leave the property in a reasonably clean and tidy condition.

- Empty the refrigerator and freezer of any leftover food.
- Empty the dishwasher and put all dishes away.
- Clean the BBQ, replace the cover, and turn off the gas cylinder.
- Empty all trash bins (bathrooms, kitchen, toilet bin, and ashtray) and dispose of the waste in the black outdoor trash bin.
- Return the house to the way it was when you arrived:
 - Put everything back in its original place.
 - Fold and put away the blankets, poufs, cushions, and other decorative items.
 - Put children's toys back where you found them.
 - Reconnect anything that was unplugged.
 - Pick up and dispose of all pet waste.
- Please let us know about any accidental damage or breakages that may have occurred during your stay.

HOUSE RULES

N.1

SEPTIC TANK

Please do not flush anything down the toilet except for toilet paper.

Please do not pour anything down the sink except for dishwater.

NON-SMOKING HOME

Smoking is strictly prohibited in the accommodation.

PROPERTY CARE

Thank you for taking good care of the furniture, equipment, and the property throughout your stay.

HEATING & ENERGY

All the radiators are connected, so please do not turn them off.

You can adjust the temperature directly on the radiator.

Do not dry anything on them.

WHAT TO DO IF...



ONE OR MORE RADIATORS ARE FLASHING

They detect when you open the windows and automatically go into “pause” mode. To stop the beeping, simply press the button with the window icon on it. Be sure to turn them back on before leaving the house, or you won't have any heat when you get home in the evening.

THERE'S A POWER OUTAGE

The main circuit breaker is located in the living room, inside the wooden box on the wall. The electrical panel is located in the utility room off the kitchen.

THERE'S NO INTERNET CONNECTION

The internet router is located in the TV cabinet in the English-style living room. You can try unplugging it for 10 seconds and then plugging it back in.

THE ALARM GOES OFF

On your keychain, there is a tag that you need to swipe over the silver star on the alarm unit.

THERE IS NO MORE HOT WATER

Make sure the water heater circuit breaker (CE/water heater in the electrical panel) is set to “auto.”

We have the largest hot water tank available. If there are 8 of you, you'll need to limit your shower time or take turns so that everyone gets hot water.
